MEET THE REEVES FAMILY

The Reeves are a very special family. Parents Brian and Kathleen, who already have grown children of their own, heard about several children with high-needs medical conditions who were up for adoption. Knowing few parents might be up for the challenge, Brian and Kathleen offered to adopt all seven children and give them a loving home. These amazing kids range in age from five to 16 years old and six of them have been approved for a wish from Children's Wish.

The oldest of the bunch, Jane, is 16 years old and loves fantasy and music. She suffers from congenital heart disease, has gone through heart surgery and now lives with a pacemaker. Her favourite thing to imagine is rocking out and being friends with the band KISS – especially Starchild. For her wish, she traveled to Vancouver to see KISS "for real." She saw the band in concert and got to meet them backstage! Weeks later, she was still showing people photos of her wish.

The next oldest, Claire, is 13 years old and has a rare genetic disorder. She is g-tube fed and requires a wheelchair. She loves the little things in life; like the sound of bells, watching fish swim and the taste of berries. At the moment, Claire's wish is to take a Disney Cruise.

Eleven-year-old Kyle has PANDAS hypertension, congenital hepatic fibrosis, and polycystic kidney disease. Kyle spends his time reading and playing piano, and loves the family cat Mirabelle. When he grows up, he would like to work in an arcade and own a fleet of vending machines. He has not decided on his wish, but he is thinking about travelling to Atlantis Paradise Island.

His brother, Gavin, is 10 years old and lives with a heart transplant. He is very friendly and loves music just like Jane. He likes learning about rock stars and uses music to balance himself. For his wish, Gavin decided to go to Disney World with his whole family. He loves spending time with his family, especially his younger siblings that he helps take care of.

Also 10 years old is Charlotte, who has congenital myotonic dystrophy. Charlotte is a big fan of Disney soundtracks and loves to swim. When she grows up, she'd like to work in a movie theatre. For her wish, she is planning on taking a Disney World trip like her brother Gavin.

Last, but definitely not least, is Zoe. She is five years old and has brittle bone disease. Because of the risk of breaking her bones, she spends much of her time in a wheelchair. She loves to watch Paw Patrol and Wonder Woman. Her favourite animals are elephants and horses, so for her wish she wants to do something with horses.

This loving family epitomizes the kindness and generosity in the

Children's Wish community. They are giving back to Children's Wish by sharing their story and spreading awareness of the magic of a wish. Speaking about Jane's wish, mom Kathleen said this: "It is undeniable that this experience made Jane feel special and gave her something very special to remember and share for the rest of her life. It was amazing and moving to share in this with my daughter. Thank you Children's Wish Foundation!"


